

NOTIFICATION OF INTENT TO CLOSE CCR LANDFILL
Golden Valley Electric Association
Healy Power Plant
Healy, Alaska

This Notification of Intent to Close CCR Landfill has been prepared pursuant to 40 C.F.R. §257.102(g) of the Coal Combustion Residuals (CCR) Rule¹ promulgated under Subtitle D of the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA).

Golden Valley Electric Association (GVEA) owns and operates an Ash Drying Area, defined as a CCR landfill under the CCR Rule, at the Healy Power Plant in Healy, Alaska. This Notification documents that GVEA intends to cease placement of all CCR and non-CCR waste in the Ash Drying Area and initiate closure on April 11, 2021. GVEA intends to close the Ash Drying Area using the closure-by-removal method as described in §257.102(c). Closure of the Ash Drying Area will be completed in a manner consistent with the written Closure Plan dated October 2016, as amended February 2021.

This notification has been placed in GVEA's facility operating records in accordance with §257.105(i)(7) of the CCR Rule, and will be posted to GVEA's CCR Rule Compliance Data and Information website pursuant to §257.107(i)(7).
