

NOTIFICATION OF INTENT TO CLOSE CCR SURFACE IMPOUNDMENTS
Golden Valley Electric Association
Healy Power Plant
Healy, Alaska

This Notification of Intent to Close CCR Surface Impoundments has been prepared pursuant to 40 C.F.R. §257.102(g) of the Coal Combustion Residuals (CCR) Rule¹ promulgated under Subtitle D of the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA).

Golden Valley Electric Association (GVEA) owns and operates three unlined coal combustion residual (CCR) surface impoundments (the Ash Pond, the Recirculating Pond and the Emergency Overflow Pond) at the Healy Power Plant in Healy, Alaska. This Notification documents that GVEA intends to cease placement of CCR and non-CCR waste streams in the three CCR surface impoundments on and initiate closure of the units on April 11, 2021. GVEA intends to close the three surface impoundments using the closure-by-removal method described in §257.102(c). Closure of the surface impoundments will be completed in a manner consistent with the written Closure Plan dated October 2016, as amended February 2021.

This notification has been placed in GVEA's facility operating records in accordance with §257.105(i)(7) of the CCR Rule, and will be posted to GVEA's CCR Rule Compliance Data and Information website pursuant to §257.107(i)(7).
