Rule 21. Goodcents Program

21.01 Goodcents

In a 2010 Bylaw Amendment, Members approved language permitting the Association to establish a program to round up all Members' bills for Electric Service to the nearest dollar. It specified that the monies collected shall be used for charitable purposes in the Association's Service Territory Area and that Members are automatically enrolled in this program. A Member may voluntarily choose not to participate by contacting the Association. See Section 21.04 (Voluntarily Choosing Not to Participate in the Goodcents Program).

The Goodcents Program will provide financial support to community non-profit groups. Members participating in the program will contribute an average of \$6.00 per year or \$0.50 per month. T

21.02 Golden Valley Electric Foundation, Inc.

Member contributions to the Goodcents Program will be transferred to the Golden Valley Electric Foundation, Inc., a 501(c)(3) Charitable Organization. A Member's bill will indicate the current amount contributed to the Goodcents Program. A six-member voluntary board will oversee the Golden Valley Electric Foundation, review applications, and approve grants to qualifying local non-profit groups within the Association's Service Territory Area. T

21.03 Goodcents Project Requirements

Non-profit groups in the Association's Service Territory Area may apply for Goodcents funds. Applications are available at www.gvea.com. Non-profit groups based outside of the Association's Service Territory Area are welcome to apply for a grant if their work affects those in need within the Association's Service Territory Area. T

21.04 Voluntarily Choosing Not to Participate in the Goodcents Program

- (c) Contact the Association in person at any of the Association's offices.

The telephone and email options are available twenty-four (24) hours a day.

If at any time during the first three (3) years of enrollment, a Member wants their Goodcents Program contributions returned, the Member may contact the Association and the entire amount contributed will be credited to their electric account.


