Rule 23. Experimental Renewable Resource Purchase Program

23.01 Experimental Renewable Resource Purchase Program

The Experimental Renewable Resource Purchase (ERRP) program was established by the Association, on an experimental basis, to purchase power from eligible Members that own and operate an Approved Renewable Resource Electric Generation Facility at a nameplate capacity rating greater than that allowed under the Sustainable Natural Alternative Power (SNAP) program, but under a nameplate capacity rating which does not exceed 2,000 kW.

23.02 Eligibility

Seller must be a Member of the Association and own and operate an Approved Renewable Resource Electric Generation Facility with a nameplate capacity that does not exceed 2,000 kW.

Member-owners may sell power and receive payment from the Association under one of the following options: 1) Special Contract, or 2) the Association's avoided cost. See Schedule No. QF-2 (Avoided Cost).

The Association will interconnect with member-owned small scale renewable resources under the ERRP program in accordance with the terms of the *Standard Power Purchase Agreement for Member-Owned Small-Scale Renewable Resources under the Experimental Renewable Resource Purchase Program* which may be amended from time to time. Members may obtain a copy of the agreement at the Association's main office.

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
