

DIRECTOR EDUCATION

I. OBJECTIVE

To ensure that directors meet the educational requirements specified in GVEA Bylaws for Director Certification and continue to update their skills after certification.

II. POLICY

- A. A newly-elected director must obtain a National Rural Electric Cooperative Association (NRECA) Credentialed Cooperative Director's Certification (CCD) within two and one-half consecutive years of service as a director in order to stand for reelection to succeed himself.
- B. Directors are strongly encouraged to annually attend a minimum of one course, seminar or workshop sponsored by Alaska Power Association (APA), National Rural Electric Cooperative Association (NRECA) or Northwest Public Power Association (NWPPA), National Rural Utilities Cooperative Finance Corporation (NRUCFC), CoBank or other organizations as approved by the Board of Directors. Attendance must be pre-approved by the Board of Directors.

III. RESPONSIBILITY

The Chairman of the Board will be responsible for ensuring compliance with this policy.
